What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	<ul> <li>\$2,000/Individual, \$4,000/Family preferred in-network providers;</li> <li>\$4,000/Individual, \$8,000/Family non-preferred in-network providers;</li> <li>\$5,000/Individual, \$10,000/Family out-of-network providers.</li> <li>Deductible applies to most services, including prescription drugs.</li> </ul>	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. Professional services with copays, in-network preventive services.
